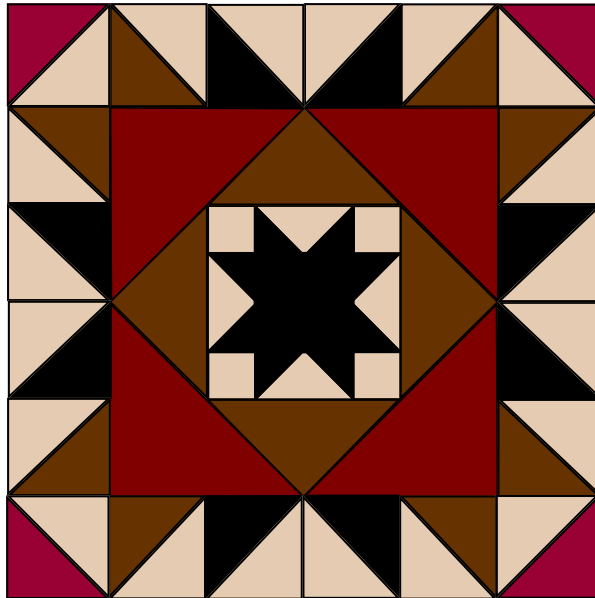


SCRAP BASKET BLOCK-#9

DIRECTIONS FOR 6" FINISHED-BLOCK 9 IS MADE UP OF...

1- 2" FINISHED STAR BLOCK:

CUT 1-1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " BLACK CENTER SQUARE

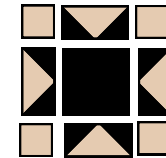
CUT 4-1 $\frac{3}{8}$ " BLACK SQUARES 

CUT 1-2 $\frac{1}{4}$ " TAN SQUARE 

CUT 4-1" TAN SQUARES



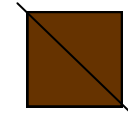
MAKE 4



STITCH STAR BLOCK

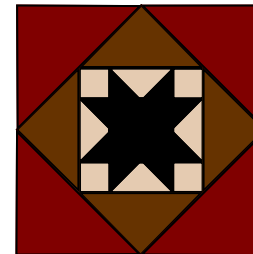
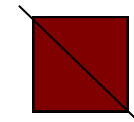
CUT 2-2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " BROWN SQUARES-CUT IN HALF

STITCH TO CENTER STAR-TRIM LEAVING
 $\frac{1}{4}$ " SEAM ALLOWANCE TO THE
RIGHT OF THE CENTER STAR.



CUT 2- 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " RED SQUARES-CUT IN HALF

STITCH TO BLOCK



CUT 10-1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " TAN SQUARES

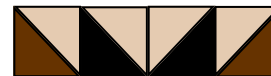
CUT 4-1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " BROWN SQUARES

CUT 4-1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " BLACK SQUARES

CUT 2-1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " RED SQUARES

CUT ALL SQUARES IN HALF TO MAKE 16 HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE UNITS. OR I STRONGLY SUGGEST USING 1" FINISHED TRIANGLE PAPER TO MAKE LOTS OF 1" FINISHED TRIANGLES.

STITCH HALF SQUARE TRIANGLE TOGETHER TO MAKE 4 OF THIS UNIT.



STITCH TWO OF THE UNIT TO THE BLOCK. STITCH THE 4 RED/TAN HALF SQUARE TRIANGLES TO THE REMAINING TWO UNITS. STITCH TO BLOCK TO COMPLETE THE BLOCK.

BLOCK SHOULD MEASURE 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ "
