

"PIECED" STITCH ALONG

- FOR THOSE WHO WANT AN ALL PIECED VERSION •



CUTTING: 2" Star Block (finished)

Black 1 - 1½" x 1½" square (star center)
 4 - 1⅜" x 1⅜" squares (flying geese)

Tan 1 - 2¼" x 2¼" (flying geese)
 4 - 1" x 1" squares (corner squares)
 2 - 1" x 2½" (little star border sides)
 2 - 1" x 3½" (little star border top & bottom)

CUTTING: 6" Star Block (finished)

Red 1 - 4¼" square (flying geese)
 4 - 2" squares (corner squares)

Tan 4 - 2⅜" squares (flying geese)

MAKING FLYING GEESSE:

Using your 2 fabrics make the following flying geese units, follow the directions below:


2" Star Block - Flying Geese

Cut 4 - 1⅜" x 1⅜" squares of Black fabric
 Cut 1 - 2¼" x 2¼" square of Tan fabric




6" Star Block - Flying Geese


Cut 4 - 2⅜" squares of Tan fabric
 Cut 1 - 4¼" square of Red fabric



With right sides of fabric together, lay two of the smaller squares on the larger square, as shown. Using a ruler or quick quarter, draw 2 diagonally lines a ¼" from the center diagonal. Stitch a scant ¼" on both drawn lines. Cut apart on the center diagonal. Press seams toward the triangle units.




Draw 2 lines on the wrong side of the remaining 2 squares as shown above. With right sides together, lay on each of the marked squares on the sewn unit and stitch on drawn lines. Cut apart on center diagonal. Press toward the triangle units.



2" CENTER STAR BLOCK - press seams open

Stitch 2 of the 4 Black and Tan flying geese units to each side of the Black center $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Continue by stitching together 2 - 1" x 1" Tan squares to each side of the remaining 2 Black and Tan flying geese and attach to the top and bottom of the center.


Add the borders by stitching the Tan border to the sides first and then add the top and bottom borders. Block should measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ ", including seam allowances.



6" STAR BLOCK - press seams open

Stitch 2 of the 4 Red and Tan flying geese to the sides of the Black star block.

Stitch the Red 2" x 2" corner squares to each side of the remaining 2 flying geese and attach to the top and bottom of the Black star block. Block should measure $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " including seam allowance.
