

Our Flag Stands for Freedom

OOPS! WE REVISED THIS PATTERN

FABRICS NEEDED:

1 FQ Bundle **OR**

10 FQ red

8 FQ Blue

15 FQ lights

} *There is enough fabric for both size quilts*

CUTTING FOR RED FABRIC SHOULD BE ~

From 6 of the 10 Red FQ, cut:

1 - 4" x 4" square - HST

3 - 3½" x 3½" squares - star blocks

MINI: 1 - 2½" x 2½" square - HST

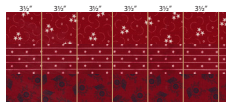
3 - 2" x 2" squares - star blocks

From each of the 10 Red FQ, cut:

3 - 3½" x 22" strips

Strip piece in sets of 3, sub-cut into 3½" x 9½" units

MINI: 2 - 2" strips - same as above, sub-cut into 2" x 5" units



CUTTING FOR BLUE FABRIC SHOULD BE ~

From 6 of 8 Blue FQ, cut:

1 - 4" x 4" square - HST

MINI: 1 - 2½" x 2½" square - HST

From each of the 8 Blue FQ, cut:

3 - 3½" x 22" strips - sub-cut into 3½" squares

MINI: 2 - 2" strips - sub-cut into 2" squares

CUTTING FOR LIGHT FABRIC SHOULD BE ~

From each of the 15 light FQ, cut:

2 - 3½" x 22" strips - (we used the stripes as light fabrics)

Strip piece in sets of 3, sub-cut into 3½" x 9½" units

2 - 3½" x 3½" squares for star centers - only 21 needed

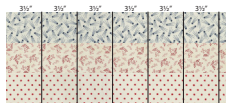
1 to 2 - 2" strips - cut into 8 or 16 squares for stars -

each star takes 8 squares, some prints are used twice

MINI: 2" strips - combine the lights and the 3 medium strips to strip piece in sets of 3, sub-cut into 2" x 5" units

1¼" strip - cut into 8 or 16 squares for stars -

each star takes 8 squares, some prints are used twice
