



American Quilters Stitch-Along

Block #2 - Heart

CONSISTS OF:

- 2 - rectangles
- 3 - simple folded corners

CUTTING:

From light fabric, cut:

- 2 - 2½" x 4½" rectangle (A)

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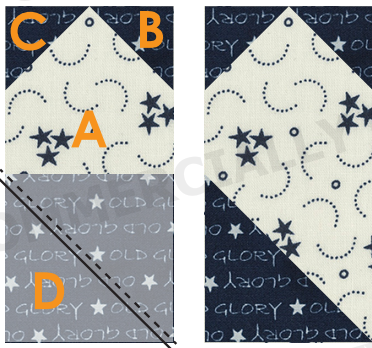
- 2 - 1¼" squares (B)
- 2 - 1½" squares (C)
- 2 - 2½" squares (D)
- 2 - 1⅛" x 5¾"
- 2 - 1⅛" x 4½"



DIRECTIONS:

Place a (B) square on the corners of each of the (A) rectangles. Stitch across the diagonal.

Trim extra fabric to ¼" away from the seam line. Press toward the corners.



Repeat for (C) and (D) squares.



Stitch both sides of the heart together to complete block. Press seams open. Block will measure 4½" x 4½".



Finish pieced block by stitching 2 - 1⅛" x 4½" dark strips to the sides, pressing seams away from block. Stitch 2 - 1⅛" x 5¾" to the top and bottom, pressing seams away from block.
