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STARCH FABRIC: Starch all fabrics completely wet, hang to dry. When completely dry, iron.

CUTTING - PIECED BLOCK:

From light fabric, cut:

- 4 - $1\frac{7}{8}$ " squares - FG - cut in half once diagonally
- 4 - $1\frac{3}{8}$ " squares - FG - cut in half once diagonally
- $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square - center block



From dark fabric, cut:

- $3\frac{1}{4}$ " square - FG - cut in half twice diagonally
- $2\frac{1}{4}$ " square - inner star block FG - cut in half twice diagonally
- 2 - $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x $4\frac{1}{2}$ " strips - block border
- 2 - $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x $5\frac{3}{4}$ " strips - block border
- 4 - $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " square - 4 corners
- 4 - 1" x 1" squares - inner star block 4 corners



STRIPES FOR EACH FLAG BLOCK:

- 4 - $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{4}$ " of different red prints
- 3 - $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " of different red prints
- 3 - $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $8\frac{1}{4}$ " of different cream prints
- 3 - $1\frac{1}{4}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " of different cream prints

DIRECTIONS:

MAKE FLYING GEESE: Using light and dark triangles from the 4 - $1\frac{3}{8}$ " light squares and the $2\frac{1}{4}$ " dark square, stitch 4 flying geese units by stitching one dark triangle to the right side of light triangle, then stitch the remaining dark triangle to the other side. Flying geese units will measure 1 " x $1\frac{1}{2}$ " at this point. Repeat to make the outer star by using the triangles from the 4 - $1\frac{7}{8}$ " light squares and the $3\frac{1}{4}$ " dark square. The larger flying geese units will measure $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " at this point.



Gather together 4 - 1" blue squares and 4 flying geese units. Lay out all the units making up the center star block. Stitch together into 3 rows, pressing seams in alternating directions. Stitch the 3 rows together and press seams open.



Lay out all the units and stitch together into 3 rows, pressing seams in alternating directions. Stitch the 3 rows together and press seams open.



Finish pieced block by stitching 2 - 1 1/8" x 4 1/2" dark strips to the sides, pressing seams away from block. Stitch 2 - 1 1/8" x 5 3/4" to the top and bottom, pressing seams away from block.



Stitch together 4 - 1 1/4" x 8 1/4" different red strips with 3 - 1 1/4" x 8 1/4" cream strips. Trim left side and stitch to the pieced block.



Stitch together 3 - 1 1/4" x 13 1/2" different red and different cream strips. Trim left side and stitch to pieced block and strip set. Trim block to 10 1/4" x 12 1/2".
