

# LAYERS OF FUN

FINISHED SIZE: 63" x 81"

**PLEASE READ ALL DIRECTIONS BEFORE BEGINNING...**

## FABRICS NEEDED:

- 42 - 10" Squares (one layer cake)
- F8 - (9" x 22") center of block
- 3 yards - setting squares & binding (we used 1040-21)
- 5 yards - backing

## PREPARING YOUR FABRICS:

Starch all fabrics completely wet, hang to dry. When completely dry, iron and stack for cutting.

## CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS:

- From 31 medium or dark 10" squares - cut 4 - 4½" x 4½"
- From 11 light or medium 10" squares - cut 12 - 1½" x 4½"
- Cut 32 - 9½" x 9½" - setting squares
- Cut 31 - 1½" x 1½" - center of blocks

## INSTRUCTIONS:

Stitch two sets of the 2 - 4½" x 4½" and 1 - 1½" x 4½" together to make the first and third row of the block.

Stitch 2 - 1½" x 4½" and 1 - 1½" x 1½" together to stitch the second row of blocks.



Stitch each row together as shown. You will need a total of 31 blocks.





Once all 31 blocks are stitched, layout the rows alternating a setting block and a stitched block as shown. Stitch rows together.

Layer with batting and backing and quilt. For binding cut 8 strips at 2" and apply to quilt.
