

Dew Drops



The Dew Drops Block combines half-square triangles, quarter-square triangles, and a central four-patch unit to create a structured yet flowing design. The arrangement of shapes creates a soft, organic pattern, echoing the quiet beauty of morning dew.

Cutting Instructions

Qty	9" finished block 5A	9" finished block 5B
1	4½" square, cut in quarters diagonally (A)	4½" square, cut in quarters diagonally (F)
8	2½" squares (A)	2½" squares (F)
4	2½" squares (B)	2½" squares (G)
4	2½" squares (C)	2½" squares (H)
2	4½" squares, cut in quarters diagonally (D)	4½" squares, cut in quarters diagonally (I)
4	2" squares (D)	2" squares (I)
1	4½" square, cut in quarters diagonally (E)	4½" square, cut in quarters diagonally (J)
12	1¼" squares (E)	1¼" squares (J)




Use these blocks to plan color and fabric placement!

 Depending on your planned layout, Fabric A and F may be the same 'Background' fabric.



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Piecing Instructions


Step 1

On the wrong side of each 2½" A/F square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner as shown.

Place A/F and B/G squares right sides together. Stitch a scant ¼" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut the square apart on the line to yield two HSTs, and press the seams to the darker triangles.

Repeat to make (8) A/F-B/G and (8) A/F-C/H HSTs.

Trim HSTs to 2".



Step 2


On the wrong side of each 1¼" E/J square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner as shown.

Line up (2) E/J squares with opposite corners of D/I square, right sides together, as shown. Stitch on the line, or just a thread's width outside the line. Trim away ¼" seam allowance, and press to the E/J triangles.

Repeat on third corner. Make (2) Diagonal Post units with seams pressed OUT to the E/J triangles.

Make (2) Diagonal Post units with seams pressed IN to the D/I squares, so the seams will nest when assembled.

Trim units to 2".




Step 3

Lay out (1) A/F, (2) D/I, and (1) E/J quarter triangles as shown.

Join triangles into pairs, pressing seams to D/I triangles.

Join pairs to form Quarter-Square Triangle unit.

Repeat to make (4) QSTs. Trim to 3½".





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
Piecing Instructions, continued

Step 4

Lay out HSTs as shown. Join units to form a corner HST unit.
 Press seams open.

Repeat to make (4) corner HST units.


Trim to 3½".



Step 5

Lay out Diagonal Post units as shown, alternating the seam
 direction of the units. Join units to form the center X unit.
 Press seams open.


Trim unit to 3½".



Step 6

Lay out HST corner units, QSTs, and center X unit as shown.
 Join to form the block.

Trim blocks to 9½".
