


The Carousel Waltz Block combines half-square triangles and a central pinwheel to create a flowing, rhythmic design. The repeating shapes and soft rotation evoke the graceful motion of a carousel, bringing a playful yet elegant feel to the block.



Cutting Instructions

Qty	9" finished block 14A	9" finished block 14B
2	4" squares (A)	4" squares (E)
2	4" squares (B)	4" squares (F)
4	3½" x 2" rectangles (C)	3½" x 2" rectangles (G)
2	2½" squares (C)	2½" squares (G)
4	3½" x 2" rectangles (D)	3½" x 2" rectangles (H)
2	2½" squares (D)	2½" squares (H)



Use these blocks to plan color and fabric placement!

 Depending on your planned layout, Fabric A and D may be the same 'Background' fabric.



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
Piecing Instructions

Step 1

On the wrong side of each 4" A/E square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner as shown.

Place 4" A/E and B/F squares right sides together. Stitch a scant $\frac{1}{4}$ " on both sides of the drawn line. Cut the square apart on the line to yield two HSTs, and press the seams to the darker triangles.

Repeat to make (4) A/E-B/F HSTs. Trim HSTs to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".




(1) A/E square + (1) B/F square =
(2) A/E-B/F HSTs

Step 2

Follow the process in Step 1 to make (4) C/G-D/H HSTs.

Trim HSTs to 2".




(1) C/G square + (1) D/H square =
(2) C/G-D/H HSTs
Make (4).

Step 3

Lay out C/G and D/H rectangles in pairs as shown.

Join to form Split Square units. Make (4).


Trim units to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".



Step 4

Lay out C/G-D/H HSTs as shown.

Join to form center unit. Trim to $3\frac{1}{2}$ ".




Step 5

Lay out HSTs, Split Squares, and center unit as shown.

Join to form the block.

Trim blocks to $9\frac{1}{2}$ ".
