


The Criss-Cross Applesauce Block weaves half-square triangles and flip-corner units into a striking layered design. The overlapping diamonds and crosses create a sense of symmetry and motion, like petals spinning around a center.


Cutting Instructions

Qty	18" finished block
4	8" squares (A)
4	2" x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles (B)
2	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (B)
4	2" x 5 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles (C)
2	2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares (C)
12	4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares (D)
4	3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2 $\frac{3}{4}$ " rectangles (D)
8	2" squares (D)

Piecing Instructions


Step 1

On the wrong side of each 4¼" D square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner as shown.

Line up (2) D squares with opposite corners of an A square, right sides together, as shown. Stitch on the line, or just a thread's width outside the line. Trim away ¼" seam allowance, and press to the D triangles.

Repeat on third corner, pressing seam to the D triangle.

Repeat all steps to make (4) A-D Diagonal Post units.




Step 2

On the wrong side of each 2½" B square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner as shown.

Place B and C squares right sides together. Stitch a scant ¼" on both sides of the drawn line. Cut the square apart on the line to yield two HSTs, and press the seams to the darker triangles.


Repeat to make (4) B-C HSTs. Trim HSTs to 2".



Step 3

Lay out B-C HSTs as shown.

Join to form center unit. Trim to 3½".



Step 4

Lay out B and C rectangles in pairs as shown. Join to form unit, and press seams open. Make (4).



Step 5


On the wrong side of each 2" D square, draw a line from one corner to the opposing corner as shown.

Line up (1) D square with a corner of a pieced B-C unit, right sides together, as shown. Stitch on the line, or just a thread's width outside the line. Trim away 1/4" seam allowance, and press to the D triangles.

Repeat on the opposite corner so that the triangles form a point. Press seam to the D triangle.

Join the D rectangle to the pointed end of the unit, and press seams to the D fabric.

Repeat all steps to make (4) 3 1/2" x 8" point units.




Step 6

Lay out units as shown.

Join units to form the block. Press seams open.

Trim to 18 1/2".
